- a. The FAFSA is a Free Application for Federal Student Aid. You must complete a FAFSA if you are seeking financial aid assistance.
- b. When filling out the FAFSA, please be sure to include SAGU's school code, 003616.

## **III. Application Documentation**

Please Note - all required documentation must be submitted before the graduate admissions committee will review your file. The following documentation is required:

1. Graduate Application: Sections A, B, C, D, E, and F
2. Official Transcripts confirming the completion of your undergraduate degree
3. GRE Scores – When applicable.

## **IV. Graduate Admissions Committee**

Will meet to determine if an applicant meets the admissions requirements and confirms eligibility for enrollment.

## **V. Acceptance**

If all admissions requirements have been met, applicants will receive an official letter of acceptance.
