This degree is designed for those who will work in settings such as hospitals, hospice agencies, community organizations, camps for children with special needs, children's homes, orphanages, foreign countries, and a wide variety of community and professional organizations which focus on children and families.

CAREER OPPORTUNITIES

Although SAGU students may major in church leadership as a route to vocational children's ministry, many of our Child & Family Studies graduates have become children's pastors. Most graduates have found their places in a range of professional, "marketplace" roles that focus on children and families. Our graduates have pursued a variety of careers:

PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

Our program provides valuable training for any student who would like to grow in effectiveness in understanding children and their families. The scope of information, perspective, and vision provided to students in the core CFM courses is broad and varied. Whereas other universities offering such a program focus on ministry to children, SAGU students receive educational principles as those majoring in elementary education; understanding of trauma and difficulty as those majoring in counseling; principles for advocacy as those majoring in social work; and strategies for implementing child, family, and intergenerational ministries in church contexts.
