OVERVIEW

Worship Arts is a ministry preparation program fashioned in light of the leadership curriculum established in the College of Bible and Church Ministries. This is for the development of worship pastors who serve the musical needs of the Church, while serving as part of a pastoral team. In addition to the Bible core, the curriculum places an emphasis on both leadership and music courses and includes hands-on internship required credit hours.

CAREER OPPORTUNITIES

Because the Worship Arts degree is designed to prepare students for vocational ministry, most of our graduates go on to become worship pastors, music directors, or creative arts pastors. This degree program also has a significant emphasis on musical knowledge and an introduction to audio engineering training, which enables students to pursue the fields of music teaching, vocal coaching, songwriting, music performance, and audio production.

PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

The Worship Arts degree through SAGU provides valuable training and preparation for students who want to pursue worship ministry. This program promotes a well-rounded approach to music ministry because of the dual focus on courses that both develop musical mastery and cultivate leadership abilities. Worship Leadership students have four internship courses built into the degree, which allow them to partner with local church worship departments.

Highlights of this degree include specialized courses, such as: Music Theory 1 & 2, Songwriting, Worship Technologies, and Senior Recital (which gives students the opportunity to lead the campus in a night of worship).

Our students are taught by accomplished faculty with years of experience in vocational ministry and musical expertise.
