The Following Items are REQUIRED to Consider a Special Circumstances Application!

1. **FAFSA:** Complete your 2023-2024 FAFSA application at www.fafsa.gov before submitting this application.
2. **LETTER:** Submit a detailed letter that explains the circumstances that have caused an income reduction. Be as detailed as possible because we need to know exactly what has occurred to cause a change in your family's financial situation. You can send this statement via email to financialaid@sagu.edu or turn in a hard copy along with this application.
3. **DOCUMENTATION:** Based on your situation, SAGU must collect certain documentation. Please review the typical documentation needed based on your special circumstance selected below. You will be emailed to the email address you indicated above to let you know if any additional documentation is required.
4. **SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCES APPLICATION:** Select the correct option below and submit this application.

Loss of employment or drastic change in income

Documentation Needed: Your letter referenced in #2 above should specifically list who lost their job or had a drastic change in income. **You should state if that person is receiving unemployment compensation**, when the loss occurred and provide proof of job loss (letter from HR department, final pay stub, etc.)

Divorce or separation

Documentation Needed: Your letter referenced in #2 above should list the date of divorce or separation. You must submit a copy of the divorce decree or the divorce petition verifying separation or document expenses from two households.

Death of parent or spouse

Documentation Needed: Submit a copy of the death certificate.

Extremely high expenses (medical, natural disaster, etc.)

Documentation Needed: Your letter referenced in #2 above should list the specifics of your situation. You must submit documentation showing the expenses that have been paid out of pocket and not covered by insurance (submit receipts, etc.)

Dependent student has gotten married since submitting FAFSA

Documentation Needed: You will have to submit a Verification Worksheet, tax return transcripts for student and spouse and a copy of the marriage license.

2021 taxes on FAFSA had unusually high income

Documentation Needed: You must submit documentation that identifies the source of income and how funds were spent or invested and why they are not available as a resource for the upcoming year.

Other: Please explain in detail when submitting your letter.
