Reservations, full payment and ticketing must be completed no later than 90 days prior to departure. If you wish to request a specific departure city it must be listed on the registration form. Unless indicated otherwise, all airline tickets are issued from the group departure city.






DAY 1: DEPART USA - Today our tour members meet at our International

DAY 6: YAD VASHEM/ SHRINE OF THE BOOK MUSEUM/ BETHLEHEM - Begin today with a guided tour of Yad Vashem, the world Holocaust Museum. Next you will see the first century model of Jerusalem at the Israel Museum, as well the Shrine of the Book. This afternoon we will visit Bethlehem, where you will see the Church of the Nativity, the Shepherd's field, and the fields of Boaz and Ruth (lunch included). We travel back to our hotel for dinner and overnight stay in Jerusalem.

DAY 7: JEWISH QUARTER/ CAIAPHAS' HOUSE/ DAVIDSON CENTER/ DOME OF THE ROCK/ WAILING WALL -

Today we begin with a tour of the Jewish Quarter of Jerusalem. Next we visit the House of Caiaphas, where Jesus was held the night before his crucifixion. You will be guided through the Davidson Center, boasting artifacts from the Second Temple. After lunch, on to the "Wailing Wall" and Mount Moriah which is called Temple Mount. Here on the site of Solomon's Temple stands the Dome of the Rock and the El Aska Mosque. Mt. Moriah was the site of Abraham's offering of Isaac as a sacrifice. This will truly be a memorable day! Dinner will be served at your hotel in Jerusalem.

DAY 8: JERICHO/ QUMRAN/ MASADA/ DEAD SEA - We continue through the Jordan Valley to Jericho, the oldest known inhabited city in the world; there you will see the ancient Tell of Jericho and Mount of Temptation. Next we visit Qumran where the Dead Sea Scrolls were discovered. Afterwards we travel to Herod's ancient fortress of Masada, which was built high atop a mountain on the edge of the Dead Sea. Today's journey will end with time and relaxation on the shore of the Dead Sea. Dinner will be served at your hotel in Jerusalem.

DAY 9: MOUNT OF OLIVES/ GARDEN OF GETHSEMANE/ OLD CITY/ CARDO/ VIA DOLOROSA/

HOLY SEPULCHRE/ GARDEN TOMB/ FAREWELL DINNER - Today we will begin our day of touring at the Mount of Olives and descend on foot to the Garden of Gethsemane. Ancient olive trees stand there, some for more than 2000 years old. We take a walking tour of the Old City of Jerusalem, beginning at the Lions Gate where we will see the old Crusader's Church of St. Ann, the pool of Bethesda and the remains of Antonia Fortress, the site of the trial of Jesus. We will walk the Via Dolorosa and visit the Church of the Holy Sepulcher. Afterwards we will travel to the Garden Tomb where you will have a worship service and communion. This will be a truly memorable time on your tour. A farewell dinner will be served; then we travel to Tel Aviv to board the overnight flight to the U.S.A.
